The following statistics illustrate the importance of an employee recognition program:



65% of employees reported not receiving any form of recognition for their work in the last year.



70% of employees in the United States are not engaged.

68% of HR professionals agreed that employee recognition has a positive impact on retention, and **56%** said such programs also help with recruitment.



A peer-to-peer recognition model is nearly **36%** more likely to have a positive impact on an organization's bottom line than manager-only recognition.



For a greater impact, organizations should invest **1%** of payroll in recognition and integrate it into their talent strategy.
