- Positive impacts of improved recruitment and retention outweigh the perceived negative impacts associated with alleged financial burdens and downturns in productivity due to paid leave.
- More and more large employers such as Starbucks, General Mills, and Lowe's Hardware, are taking the initiative and
 providing paid parental leave.

Rob's Tips for Those Interested In Increasing Paid Parental Leave

- Advocate within your organization by bringing the issue of paid parental leave to the attention of top management or your Human Resources Team.
- Contact your state and federal representative and encourage them to bring attention to the issue.
- Join a local, state or national organization and lend your voice!
